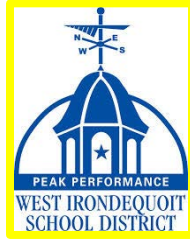


Grades K-3:

9:00–9:30	Daily Independent Reading <i>Grades K-1:</i> Read for 12 min, take a 5 minute stretch break, read for another 13 minutes <i>Grades 2-3:</i> Read for 30 minutes, taking one minute stretch breaks as needed	Any self-selected book from home, a book assigned by classroom teacher, a text found on SORA (see info regarding login info later in this packet)
9:30–10:30	Reading Instruction	As assigned by teacher

10:15-11:00	Math	As assigned by teacher
11:00-11:15	Play Break	Get outside and play if you can!
11:15 – 12:15	LUNCH	
12:15- 1:00	Specials Areas	Pick one of the specials area at home learning experiences to complete.
